

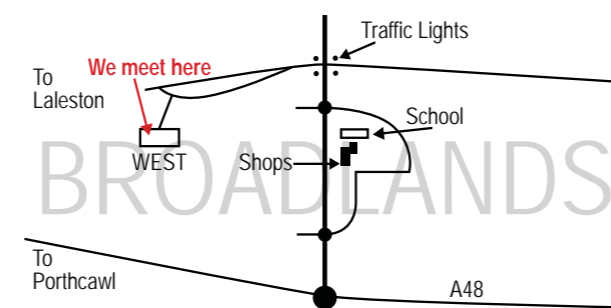

Broadlands Evangelical Church (BEC) is a growing independent church that meets in the heart of the Broadlands community. We are a group of Christians who believe that everyone's greatest need is a relationship with God. We believe that the only way to have this relationship is through Jesus Christ. We also believe that the only way to know Jesus is through the Bible.

Our aim in all things is to worship God with all our heart, mind and lives. Part of worshipping the God of the Bible is telling everyone about the 'good news' of Jesus.

We are a church made up of a variety of ages and backgrounds. We offer a warm welcome to newcomers and visitors from all walks of life.

At BEC we have a number of meetings throughout the week – the aim of these meetings is to study the Bible, pray to God, encourage each other to grow in faith and enjoy each other's company as a family.

Sunday – Our weekly service is held at WEST (see map) from 10am until 11.15am. This is a time for us to worship God together and study his Word. All are very welcome to this meeting.

Tuesday – at 1.30pm, the ladies meet together informally for a time of Bible study and prayer. All ladies are warmly invited.

Wednesday – the church runs a Parents and Toddlers group (Upper Room Toddlers). It is held upstairs in the Med Lounge Coffee Shop on Broadlands, between 9.30am and 11.30am. There is a small charge to cover the cost of hiring the room.

We also meet for Bible study and prayer on a **Wednesday** evening from 7.30pm – 9.00pm. During this time we look at what the Bible teaches us about all kinds of subjects, e.g. God, life, happiness etc. We then enjoy a time of prayer for matters ranging from world affairs to personal needs. We would love you to join us or let us know items you would like us to pray for.

Introduction to Christianity Courses

Is there a God? Who is He? How can I know Him? Why is our world in such a mess? Our Introduction to Christianity courses are designed for anyone who would like to find out more about Christianity – or an opportunity to brush-up on the basics of Christianity!

We seek to make these courses accessible to as wide a range of people as possible, including families and young people. During these courses we meet in small groups. No one is asked to pray, sing or read aloud - you can simply come and listen or you can ask any question you like!

Everyone is welcome, from the most sympathetic 'Sunday-schooler' to the convinced atheist. You will always be treated with respect whatever your culture, background or beliefs.

There is no charge whatsoever for attending these courses and if you feel during the course that it is not for you, you can pull out at any time.
